

Dear Parents

I should like to provide further clarity about the reopening of the school over the forthcoming weeks as I am aware that there has been some misunderstanding from a small number of parents.

### **Years 7-9**

**The vast majority of students will continue to work at home and learn remotely. Following Government guidance the school is not opening more widely to these year groups at this time.** The school has contacted a handful of parents directly via school comms to invite their child into school for further support and those parents have been asked to contact school if they would like their child to attend. If you have not received this letter directly via School Comms, then at this time your child will continue to work from home.

### **Children of Key Workers:**

Children of key workers are able to send their children into school from Monday 8th June. There was a survey sent to parents for you to confirm that you need your child to attend school. If you have completed the survey and do need your child to attend, you will receive a letter from school tomorrow (5th) confirming the arrangements for your child.

### **Year 10 and 12**

Up to 25% of students in these year groups are able to return to school from 15th June and again parents have been asked to complete a survey if you would like your child to attend. Parents who have confirmed this will receive a letter from school next week to confirm the arrangements for 15th June onwards.

The parents of any child who is expected to attend either from the 8th June or 15th June will receive direct communication from school to confirm this. Please do not send your child to school if you have not received this direct communication from school.

I do hope this clarifies the situation for all parents and students.
